Crestline Downstairs is an Interior Community Services (ICS) supported housing resource providing individualized one-to-one support to an adult with diverse abilities. The program operates 24 hours per day with consistent staffing across three eight-hour shifts. Referrals and service coordination are completed through Community Living BC (CLBC). The mission of Crestline Downstairs is to enhance quality of life by strengthening social and community connections while promoting overall health, safety, and wellbeing.
