## Trends

The Shelter showed lower number of youth accessing bedspace for the period January - July with a higher percentage of stays over 29 days occurring. August through December showed steady residential access with 13 residential stays, 6 of which lasted 2 weeks or more (with an average of 3 weeks each stay).
